Dear Mr Jahier,

Pursuant to Article 11 of Regulation (EU, EURATOM) No 883/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11/09/2013 concerning investigations conducted by the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF), the investigation concerning Jacek KRAWCZYK on the grounds of psychological harassment in the workplace has been forwarded to my office, the competent body under Belgian law for dealing with prevention in such matters.

I would ask you to note that having read the detailed investigation conducted by OLAF, my office has decided to bring proceedings against Mr KRAWCZYK before the Criminal Court of Brussels.

For this purpose, I would be grateful if you would confirm that you are waiving the immunity that Mr KRAWCZYK enjoys.

Furthermore, I would be grateful if you would inform me of the state of play of the disciplinary proceedings immediately upon receiving this letter.

Finally, for your further information, please find in attachment copies of my letters to Ilze JUHANSONE, in her capacity as Secretary-General of the European Commission, and to Jeppe TRANHOLM-MIKKELSEN, in his capacity as Secretary-General of the European Union, informing them that legal action is being taken.
